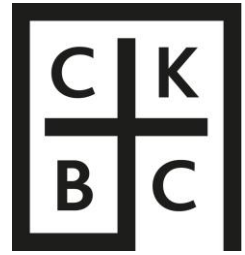


Charlton Kings Baptist Church
