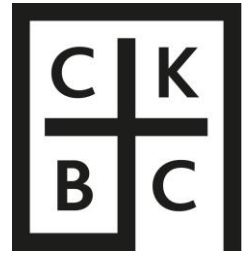


# Charlton Kings Baptist Church
